TO: ALL OWNERS, TRAINERS, JOCKEYS AND APPRENTICES

AMENDMENTS TO MRA RULES OF RACING 6(1) AND 147

The following amendments to MRA Rules of Racing 6(1) and 147 (highlighted in bold) are to be implemented with effect from 27 April 2022 :

PART I: PRELIMINARY

Interpretation

Rule 6(1)

In these Rules and any Regulations made thereunder, unless the context otherwise requires:

“Legal representation” or “Legal counsel” shall mean:

- (a) **In respect of MRA proceedings in Malaysia, representation by, or assistance from, an advocate and solicitor of the High Court of Malaya admitted under the Legal Profession Act 1976 (“the Act”) and having both a valid Practising Certificate and a Sijil Annual issued under the Act; and**

- (b) **In respect of MRA proceedings in Singapore, representation by, or assistance from, an advocate and solicitor of the Supreme Court of Singapore admitted to practice Singapore law and having a valid Practising Certificate issued under section 25 of the Legal Profession Act (Cap. 161).**

PART XI : APPEALS

Parties entitled to **Legal** representation

Rule 147

A party to an appeal shall be entitled to **Legal** representation at his own cost.
