TO: ALL TRAINERS

INCOMPLETE FORMS

Secretariat noticed that recently there are incomplete forms submitted by Trainers for transfer of horses between Trainers and change of horse ownerships.

2 Your attention is drawn to MRA Regulation 17 and MRA Rule of Racing 80(2) which read as follows:

MRA Regulation 17 - Transfer of Horses between Trainers

A receiving Trainer is responsible for the lodgement of the transfer form (which shall be in the form as may be from time to time prescribed by the Association, duly completed and endorsed by the Owner, the current Trainer and the receiving Trainer) with the Association immediately when a horse is transferred to his stable failing which the Club receiving the entry for a race may not process it and if the horse is handicapped, it may be scratched or withdrawn without notice. Provided always that this Rule shall not be applied where, in the view of the Association or Local Committee, there are exceptional circumstances, including but not limited to where it is impossible for the receiving Trainer to comply with the Rule.

MRA Rule of Racing 80(2) – Change of Ownership of Horse

The application for change of ownership shall be accompanied by written confirmation from the previous Owner together with the registration fee. Provided always that this Rule shall not apply where, in the view of the Association, there are exceptional circumstances, including but not limited to where it is impossible for the new Owner to comply with the Rule.

3 All Transfer of Horse and Application for Registration of Sale forms are to be duly endorsed and signed by all relevant parties in order for MRA to effect the transfers/sales. Incomplete forms will not be accepted by MRA.
